


PRAYER VIGIL & FUNERAL MASS FOR FR. JAMES FAGAN




ALL SOULS ENVELOPES

Completed envelopes may be submitted to the parish office or placed in the collection basket on Sunday. **Cash donations only—no cheques can be accepted.** These Mass intentions will be said by priests within a year of their offering.

PLENARY INDULGENCE & THE FEAST OF ALL SOULS

The Church has encouraged prayer for the dead from the earliest times as an act of Christian Charity. Through this deed, a person receives a plenary indulgence. “An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven...An indulgence is partial or plenary as it removes either part or all of the temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living or the dead” (*Catechism of the Catholic Church, chp2, 1471*). “Since the faithful departed now being purified are also members of the same communion of saints, one way we can help them is to obtain indulgences for them, so that the temporal punishments due for their sins may be remitted” (*Catechism of the Catholic Church, chp2, 1479*).
One suggestion during this week to aid the souls in purgatory toward heaven is to visit a cemetery and to piously pray for the departed during this week of **November 2nd to November 9th.** The three prerequisites of a plenary indulgence are (1) Sacramental Confession, (2) Holy Communion, and (3) Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father, all to be performed within several days before or after if not at the same time. The suggested prayers are one **Our Father** and one **Hail Mary** though the individual faithful are free to recite any other prayers according to their own piety and devotion toward the Supreme Pontiff.



A HOLY SOULS 30-DAY PRAYER BOOK
The faithful are called to pray for the dead especially during November, the month of Holy Souls. A Holy Souls’ 30-Day Prayer Book has been prepared by the Catholic Cemeteries to assist you with prayers and devotions throughout the season. It is available for pick-up at the Church entrance.
