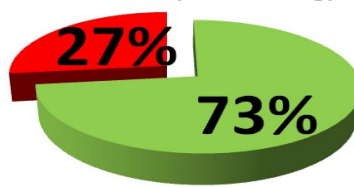
Family Participation Meter (%)
