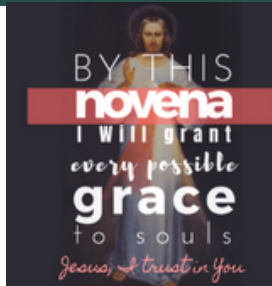
DIVINE MERCY NOVENA:

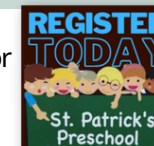
