BAPTISM PREPARATION CLASS

PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM (PREP)

Catechism for Elementary School Children
St. Patrick's offers Religion classes for children in Kindergarten to grade 7, enrolled in public or non-religious private schools. Kindergarten is taught by catechists of the **Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS)** Program. Incorporated in the program are the sacramental preparation for the First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion for Grade 2, catch-up Classes, and Confirmation Preparation for grade 7. PREP classes are on **Sundays from 10:30 am to 12:15pm** at **St. Patrick's Elementary School**.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (RCIA)

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is a weekly program from **September through June** that introduces adults to the teachings of the Catholic Church and serves as a preparation for receiving the Sacraments of Initiation. Classes are on **Thursday nights from 7:00 - 8:30 pm** at St. Patrick's Parish.

PRAY FOR SOULS: PLENARY INDULGENCE & FEAST OF ALL SOULS | NOVEMBER 2ND

The Church has encouraged prayer for the dead from the earliest times as an act of Christian Charity. Through this deed, a person receives a plenary indulgence.



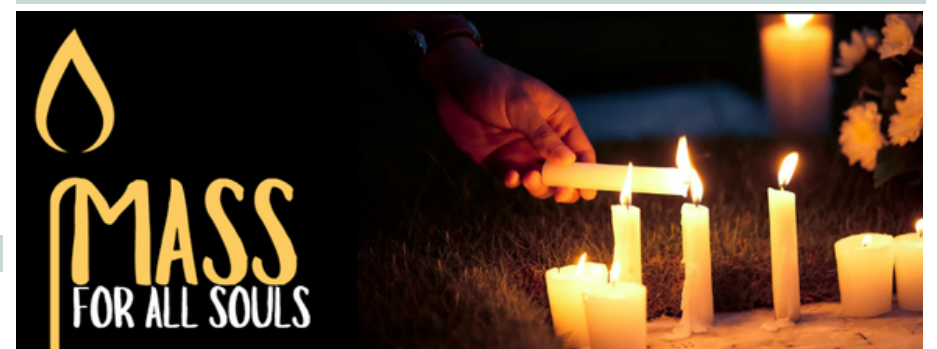
"An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven...An indulgence is partial or plenary as it removes either part or all of the temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living or the dead" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, chp2, 1471).

"Since the faithful departed now being purified are also members of the same communion of saints, one way we can help them is to obtain indulgences for them, so that the temporal punishments due for their sins may be remitted" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, chp2, 1479).

One suggestion during this week to aid the souls in purgatory toward heaven, is to visit a cemetery and to piously pray for the departed during this week of November 2nd to November 9th.

The 3 prerequisites of a plenary indulgence are:

- (1) Sacramental Confession,
- (2) Holy Communion, and
- (3) Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father, all to be performed within several days before or after if not at the same time. The suggested prayers are one Our Father and one Hail Mary though the individual faithful are free to recite any other prayers according to their own piety and devotion toward the Supreme Pontiff.



MASS FOR OUR DEPARTED LOVED ONES: ALL SOULS DAY
Saturday, Nov. 2 | 9:00 a.m. | St. Patrick's
On **November 2nd** the Church celebrates 'a **Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed** also known as **All Souls Day**. On this day we honor them for their fidelity in life, as well as pray for them, since they are being purified before entering the All Holy Presence of God.' (Source: ewtn.com). On **Saturday, November 2 at 9:00 am**, we invite all Parishioners to a special Mass, here at St. Patrick's Church, which will be offered for all our departed loved ones. At the Mass there will be an opportunity to have candles blessed (candles available by donation). These candles can be lit when praying for the souls of the faithful departed, whether that be at their graveside or in our homes. **Please note, that this central All Souls day Mass, replaces our annual grave blessing at Oceanview Cemetery.**

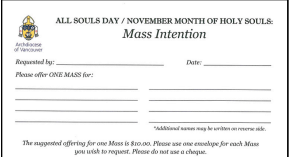

November is the month of All Souls. This month you can request to have a special Mass offered for your departed loved ones. To do so please pick up an **'All Souls Envelope'**. Envelopes are **available in the Church & parish office throughout the entire month of November**. Completed envelopes may be submitted to the parish office or placed in the Sunday offering box in the Church. Due to the limited number of envelopes available, we ask that you only take one if you intend to use it. **Please find some additional information about "All Souls" Masses below:**



- **One envelope = one Mass.**
- **Ample space for names.** Both sides of the envelope may be used for listing the names of departed loved ones for one Mass.
- **When will the Mass be celebrated?** Within one year of it being received.
- **Will I know the exact date and location of the Mass?** **No**
- **Free-will offering** (suggested offering for one Mass is \$10)
- **Cash only / No cheques**, since the stipend goes to the priest celebrating the Mass, and Mass intentions may be passed onto priests in other parishes.
